F4K bridges the gap between the hopes and dreams of our students and the workforce development needs of our communities

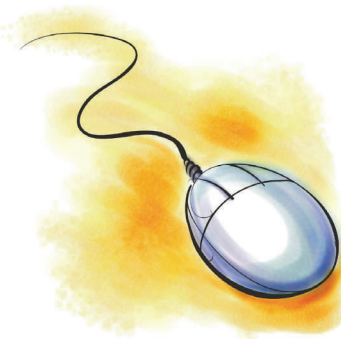
WHAT IS A CAREER COACH ?
